The District Membership Seminar will be held Saturday morning, Nov. 1, at the conference.

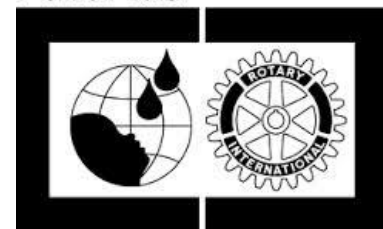
