With much gratitude to then-Governor David Bixler and every Rotarian who gave support to The Rotary Foundation, the following great things happened:

- **5** New Rotary clubs became **STAR Clubs** (Annual Fund per capita of \$100 or more); **Columbia Evening, Lake Ozark, Lebanon, Sedalia, Warrensburg**
- **1,724** Rotarians gave something to TRF
- **1,395** of those gave at least \$100
- **\$165** per capita giving to the Annual Fund
- **\$61,905** PolioPlus contributions
- **\$585,789** Total all giving to TRF
- **95** Rotarians gave at least **\$1,000 to TRF** making them **Paul Harris Society** eligible
- **80** Rotarians made estate plan gifts of **\$10,000** or more, joining **the Bequest Society**
- **59** Rotarians achieved **Major Donor** status with cumulative giving to the Annual Fund and/or PolioPlus of **\$10,000** or more
- **14** Rotarians became **Benefactors** by pledging a gift of at least **\$1,000** to The Rotary Foundation
